The Minor Illness Nurse-led Clinic

- ♦ The Minor Illness Clinic Service is designed to help the patients at Leigh Family Practice to access medical advice quickly and easily for a range of illnesses.
- ♦ The Minor Illness Clinics are run by our specially trained nurse, Sister Pat Katz who is able to offer advice and prescription treatment where appropriate.
- ♦ Minor Illness Clinic appointments can be booked up to 24 hours in advance meaning that you are seen QUICKLY.

However, these Clinics are **NOT** suitable for:

- * Pregnant Ladies
- * Conditions under ongoing GP review
- * Referral Requests
- * Conditions that have been present for more than 7 days
- * Repeat prescription requests
- * Babies under the age of one year
- * Obtaining sick notes

Kindly note - if you think that you have a water infection, cystitis or that you may require a pregnancy test please bring an early morning water sample with you to your appointment.
